————— or I

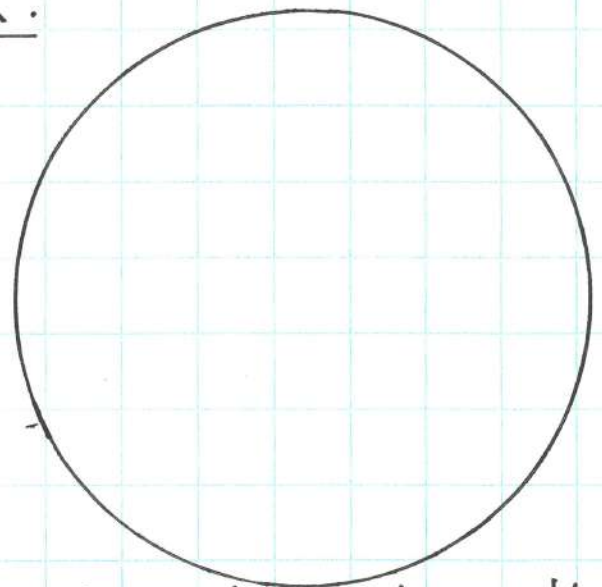
② Second predicate or truth.

The whole becomes fragmented

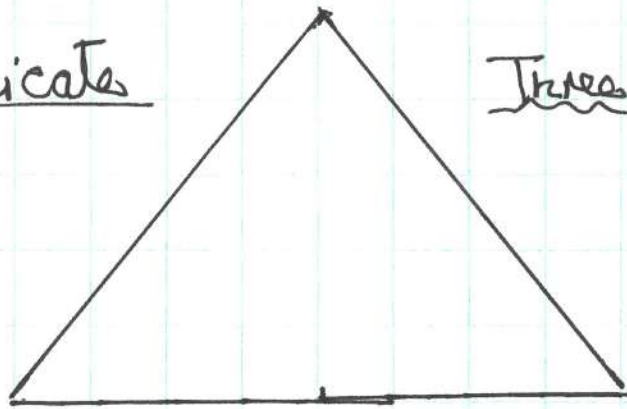
